

Learn to Skate had 16 sessions plus their own Christmas Skate. Jeff Francom and I made efforts to schedule LTS when it was difficult to schedule house league (i.e. Saturday afternoon) or when rep teams were out of town on Thursday evenings. There were 3 scheduled bunny games in Jan/Feb one of which was followed by an exhibition game with U19A playing Nipissing University. This game was well publicized and attended.

Rep teams purchased the following number of ice times from WFRA: U10 (11), U12P (21), U14A (27), U16 (17.5), U19A (55), NipU (3) for a total of 134.5 hours. The rep teams purchasing ice covered approximately \$19,500 of the Association ice bill. This is a significant point to note because in 2016-2017 the rep teams used 78 hours of ice from the Association. An Association raffle held this season resulted in significant fundraising for the teams that allowed them to afford more practice ice.

The Association gets 6 meeting rooms free of charge for each calendar year. These rooms are used for meetings, photos, Xmas skate, AGM etc.

The applications for City ice contracts for 2018 – 2019 is due May 18th.

Equipment Coordinator (Dan Sawyer): We had loaned out 26 bags of equipment this past season and we have 6 to be returned.

I was waiting for all the try outs to be finished for one more equipment return that I was going to set up with the new Equipment Director so they can see what was there and what I had done.

Sponsorship Coordinator (Kerri Moreau):

Referee-in-Chief Report (Stephen Hamilton): Current roster includes 12 officials and 16 timekeepers. Our association has been fortunate to have a good blend of developing officials combined with a veteran roster of officials.

Availability of officials with the requirements and background to officiate JBO was limited due to work commitments and injuries. This is a growth area for next year.
